**WHAT IS THE MBA PROGRAM?** The clarkson master of business administration program prepares students for leadership positions within an increasingly global and technological work environment. The MBA degree is fully accredited by AACSB.

**SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRADUATE POSITIONS:**

scholarships are awarded based on the overall strength of your candidacy and in particular; your GMAT/GRE score, undergraduate grade point average (last 60 credit hours), and three letters of reference. students are also eligible to apply for a graduate assistant position and earn up to \$1500 per semester. each year, clarkson university attracts energetic individuals with the ambition and leadership skills necessary to accept challenges, embrace change, and perform at the highest levels. The process of learning at clarkson is distinguished through rigor and collaboration, and nourished in a culture that reflects the core values of our students, staff and faculty.
