**cazenovia college** and **clarkson university** have established an agreement that allows **cazenovia** students to plan their undergraduate program to include courses that serve as a foundation for graduate study in business at **clarkson**. These foundation courses include material required in the first year of study in the Master of Business Administration (MBA) program at **clarkson**. Students who plan their undergraduate program carefully are able to earn an undergraduate degree from **cazenovia college** and an MBA degree from **clarkson** in five years. If necessary, any remaining foundation courses may be taken at **clarkson** during the summer business concepts program.

**WHAT IS THE MBA PROGRAM?** The **clarkson** Master of Business Administration program prepares students for leadership positions within an increasingly global and technological work environment. The MBA degree is fully accredited by AACSB.

**SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRADUATE POSITIONS:**

Scholarships are awarded based on the overall strength of your candidacy and in particular; your GMAT/GRE score, undergraduate grade point average (last 60 credit hours), and three letters of reference. Students are also eligible to apply for a graduate assistant position and earn up to \$1500 per semester.
