Section 7: On-Campus Housing. Please note that Clarkson is a non-smoking campus. On-campus housing reservations are to be processed through Dr. Fendler's office. Requests will be accepted until May 30, 2005. No requests will be honored if received or paid after May 30, 2005 or once all available space has been filled. To insure your on campus accommodation, reservations and payments should be made as soon as possible.

Housing on the campus of Clarkson University is available June 12-15, 2005 in dorm style residences. These facilities are primarily comprised of two one-bedroom suite apartments. The units feature two twin beds in each room and semi-private bathrooms. A pillow, blanket and linen packet will be provided upon arrival. A linen packet includes sheets, pillowcase, washcloth and two towels. Ethernet connections are available in each bedroom. Please bring your own cable for your laptop connection.

Please plan to bring any other items you may need such as personal toiletries, alarm clock, travel iron, hangers, and long distance calling card. Although rooms are very comfortable, personal services such as wake-up calls, daily maid service, room service, and dry cleaning are not available. Each apartment complex includes a lounge, recreation room, restroom facilities, vending machines and a laundry room.
