

Laboratory Science Waiver for the Class of 2010

Students in the Class of 2010 and beyond must satisfy the requirements of the Clarkson Common Experience. One component of this is a laboratory science experience. The full statement of the Common Experience Science Requirement is that students will (a) take at least two courses in the natural sciences and (b) have at least one laboratory experience either as a component of one of these science courses or as a separate natural science laboratory course.

However, some students who entered Clarkson as first-year students in Academic 2006-2007 did not have a laboratory science experience available to them when called for by their 8-semester plans. Therefore, for students in the Class of 2010, the following waiver has been approved:

Class of 2010 graduates are not required to have the natural science laboratory component of the Common Experience Science Requirement. These graduates must still take at least two courses in the natural sciences.

This waiver is automatic and does not need to be requested.
