The “Negotiations U.” project at Clarkson University concluded with a negotiations contest and dinner on Friday, Feb. 22. Twenty-five contestants competed for \$2,500 in prize money by completing a reflection essay and by presenting their cases for \$10,000 more in starting compensation to their peers and executive and faculty judges. Six contestants progressed to the finals, which required an on-stage, interactive role-play in front of their peers. The evening followed a three-hour, student-led training session on Saturday, Feb. 16 at the Adirondack Lodge and an intense week of individual participant preparation.

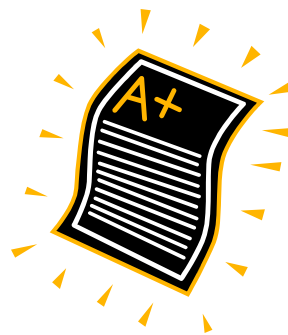
