Research Opportunity

The Center for Advocacy, Community Health, Education and Diversity (CACHED) at the University of Rochester School of Medicine & Dentistry, offers an enrichment programs designed to support and enhance the preparation of students from underrepresented groups in Medicine.

The SUMMER UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP (SURF) PROGRAM is an eight-week program designed to enhance the competitiveness of undergraduate students interested in medicine, research, and science who belong to groups historically underrepresented within these areas.

The program is designed to strengthen students' science and research skills and expose them to biomedical research and clinical medicine. Students are individually matched with preceptors (clinicians and scientists) and conduct biomedical and clinically focused research in Medical Center laboratories. Participants also attend evening presentations, departmental seminars, conferences, and lectures; MCAT Prep classes; Problem Based Learning (PBL) sessions; gross anatomy lectures and labs; and perform weekly rotations in the Emergency Medicine Department.

Applicants must have an introduction to their scientific field of interest and must have completed at least two years of college.

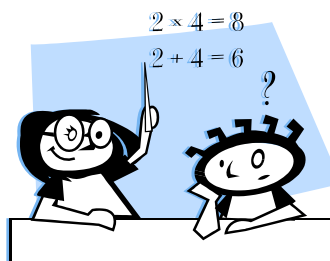
