

PSAT Prep Course

A four-week preparation course for the PSAT/NMSQT will be offered at Clarkson University beginning Saturday, September 21, 2019.

What is the PSAT/NMSQT? The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT) measures students' reading, math reasoning and writing skills. This standardized test is used to enter the competition for National Merit Scholarships.

When is the PSAT/NMSQT this year? Wednesday, October 16, 2019 (Students must register for the test through their high school guidance office.)

What is tested on the PSAT/NMSQT? Critical reading, mathematics and writing skills

What will be covered in this course? All areas of the PSAT/NMSQT are covered with a focus on test-taking strategies for each section and question type. Critical reading includes sentence completion and passage-based reading questions. Math includes multiple-choice and student-produced response questions. Writing skills include improving sentences, identifying sentence errors, and improving paragraph questions.

When will the course meet? Saturdays, September 21, 28, October 5 and 12, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Where will the course be held? Clarkson University, BH Snell Hall, Room 175

What is the registration fee for the course? \$129 (includes book and materials)
