## ABOUT THE PROGRAMS

Students will be full-time Albany College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (ACPHS) students through the completion of their ACPHS degrees. After students matriculate into Clarkson University's graduate degree program, scholarships equal to the cost of one course will be awarded to students. Tuition for additional courses will be determined by and payable directly to Clarkson University.

Specific ACPHS practicums count toward the 400-hour internship requirement. See a ACPHS or Clarkson program advisor for additional information.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To apply, please submit the following:

- Online application, which can be completed at [gradapp.clarkson.edu/apply](http://gradapp.clarkson.edu/apply).
- Essay/personal statement.
- PCAT and/or GMAT test scores; MCAT and GRE are also accepted.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Resume/CV.
- Transcripts from all postsecondary institutions attended.
- Certificate of finance for an I-20 (international students).

Generally, an undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required to be considered for admission.

Clarkson will accept the PCAT score in lieu of the GMAT (the MS has no standardized testing requirement). MBA students may want to take the GMAT so they can be considered to receive scholarships. Scholarship awards are determined by a combination of GPA and GMAT scores. Students who have not taken the PCAT will be required to submit a GMAT score if their ACPHS GPA is less than 3.2 by the start of their third year at ACPHS.

Tuition for Clarkson's graduate course(s) may be included in student loan requests if the course(s) qualifies as an elective at ACPHS.
